

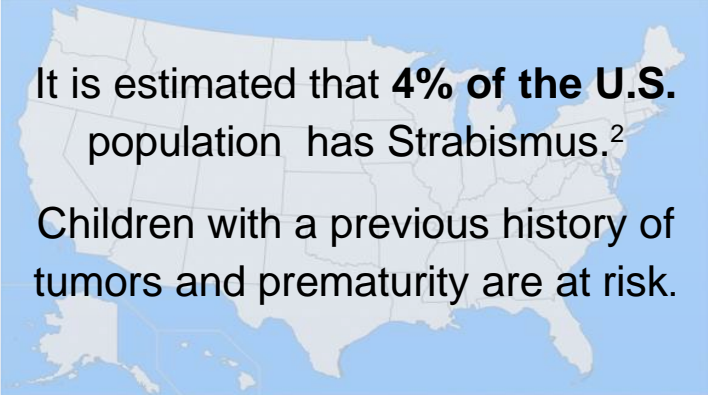

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Strabismus is the medical term used when the two eyes are not straight. It is a visual defect in which the eyes are misaligned and point in different directions. ¹

Strabismus Symptoms¹:

- Turned or crossed eye
- Squinting
- Head tilting or turning
- Double vision



It is estimated that **4% of the U.S.** population has Strabismus.²

Children with a previous history of tumors and prematurity are at risk.



How can Strabismus be prevented?¹

- ♦ Any case of poor vision in one eye in a child may lead to Strabismus
- ♦ It is recommended that all children between 3 and 3 1/2 years of age have their vision checked by an Eye Care Professional
